General

Each bead has its own color. It ranges from dark to light. If the same type of beads in different colors are used, these are also marked with different colors in the drawings. New added beads are darker than already existing beads in the piece.

Generally in my instructions the diagrams come first. The texts are additions to the pictures. The diagrams show the thread path. The letters identifying the individual beads are given in the order in which the beads are used for the first time.

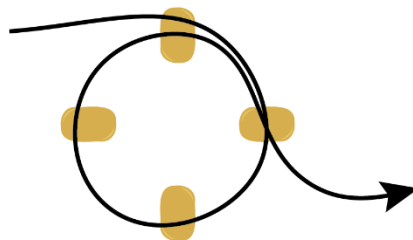

Notes to the lariat

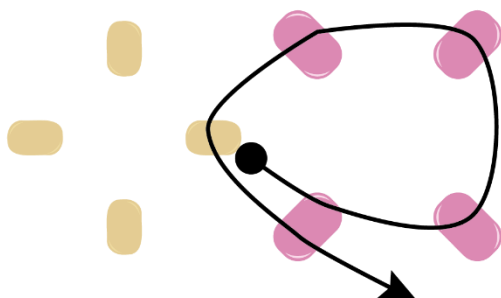
The Lariat Marina's World of Colors consists of separate strands in any desired numbers. The shown lariat consists of 4 strands with seed beads and one strand with rondelles. The length of each strand is 132 cm but can be changed to the desired length. The lariat is a real stash cleaner, as you can change the color of the seed beads within a strand and use anything between 3 and 4 mm (rondelles, fire polishes, bicones, pearls...) for the accent strand. Also the numbers of strands and the way you knot it around your neck is variable. Also a short variation with a multi-strand-clasp is thinkable. Tip: Do a new strand in a different color from time to time and mix it with the others. So over time you will have matching strands for all your outfits. Let your phantasies run wild...

On a comfortable length of thread pick up four 15/0 seed beads (B). Pass again clockwise through the first and second B.

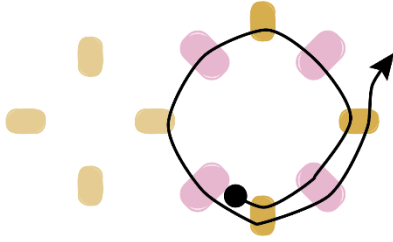

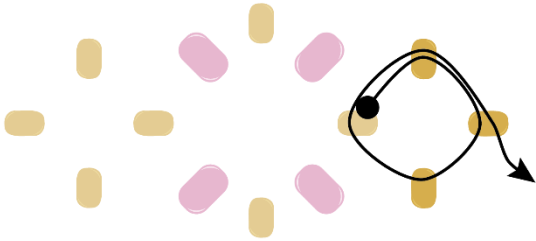
Pick up four 11/0 seed beads in the first color (A). Pass again counterclockwise through the B the thread is exiting and the first A.

Work three times one B between the A. Pass forward to the tip.

Pick up three B and circle to the tip.

Repeat steps 2 to 4 until you reach the desired length.



Repeat steps 1 to 5 with the next main color C to the desired length.



Repeat steps 1 to 5 with the next main color D to the desired length.



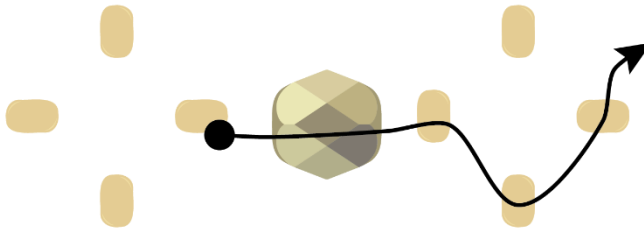
Repeat steps 1 to 5 with the next main color E to the desired length.

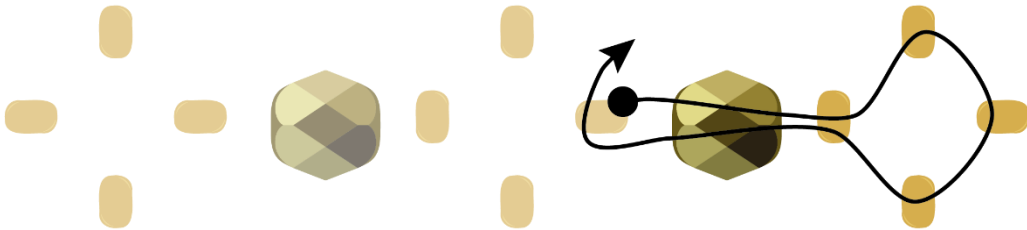
For the accent strand pick up four B and pass clockwise through the first and second B. Pick up one rondelle (F) and four B and pass back through the first picked up B, F and the starting B.

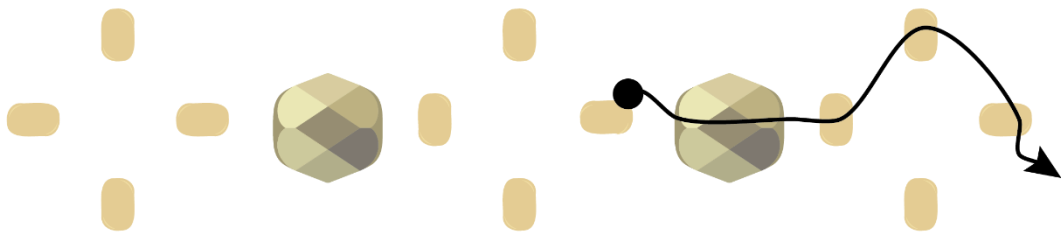


Pass again through F and three B to the tip.

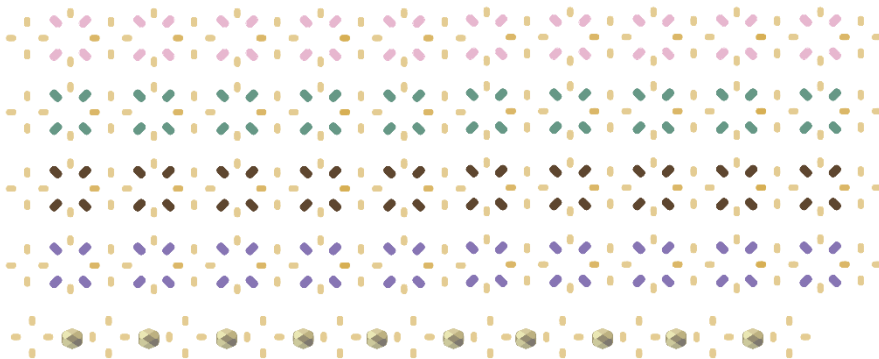
Pick up one F and four B. Pass back through the first picked up B, F and the starting B. Make sure you alternate between clockwise and counterclockwise to stabilize the strand.



Pass forward through F and three B to the tip.



Repeat steps 9 to 12 until you reach the desired length.
